# COOKIES POLICY

## INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website or make use of e-billing services.

The cookies we use store your unique user ID. This cookie enables the system to allow you to visit other pages after it has been authenticated. The cookie is used to identify what type of user you are and grants you access to functionality you would not otherwise be able to access. Our internal reports/dashboard statistics will log statistics using your login which will have been authenticated via the cookie. The cookie itself does not hold anything other than your ID and authenticating service.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.

All cookies are only stored within your browser until you either log off or close your browser.
